**There are inconceivable and marvelous verses in the New Testament of the great promises we have in Christ. How can we call these promises superfluous? God has called us to be overcomers and to be called us the sons of God. What tremendous promises we have for salvation that is ready to be revealed in the end times. We are groaning for the manifestation of the sons of God and freedom from bondage. We have many promises, concerning the wisdom of God that will be made manifest to the powers in the heavenly places through the church (Eph 3:10). Let us be sure and confident that God's word cannot be broken.**

**You may be living in an isolated place separated from the rest of the part of an unknown religion and culture, or you may be living in any way you like but God's program will unfold in the way that is determined. God's word, regardless of individual situations, cannot be broken. Ancient Israel did not believe in what God said. They did not believe it possible to possess the Promised Land. They said that it was impossible to possess the Promised Land, that the walls were far too high, and the grasshoppers in comparison to them! They did not believe in God's word and in the end they perished in the wilderness, not because God had promised to bring them in. Nevertheless, let us be confident that God's word cannot be broken.**
